King David's song when he was exiled in the Judean wilderness*

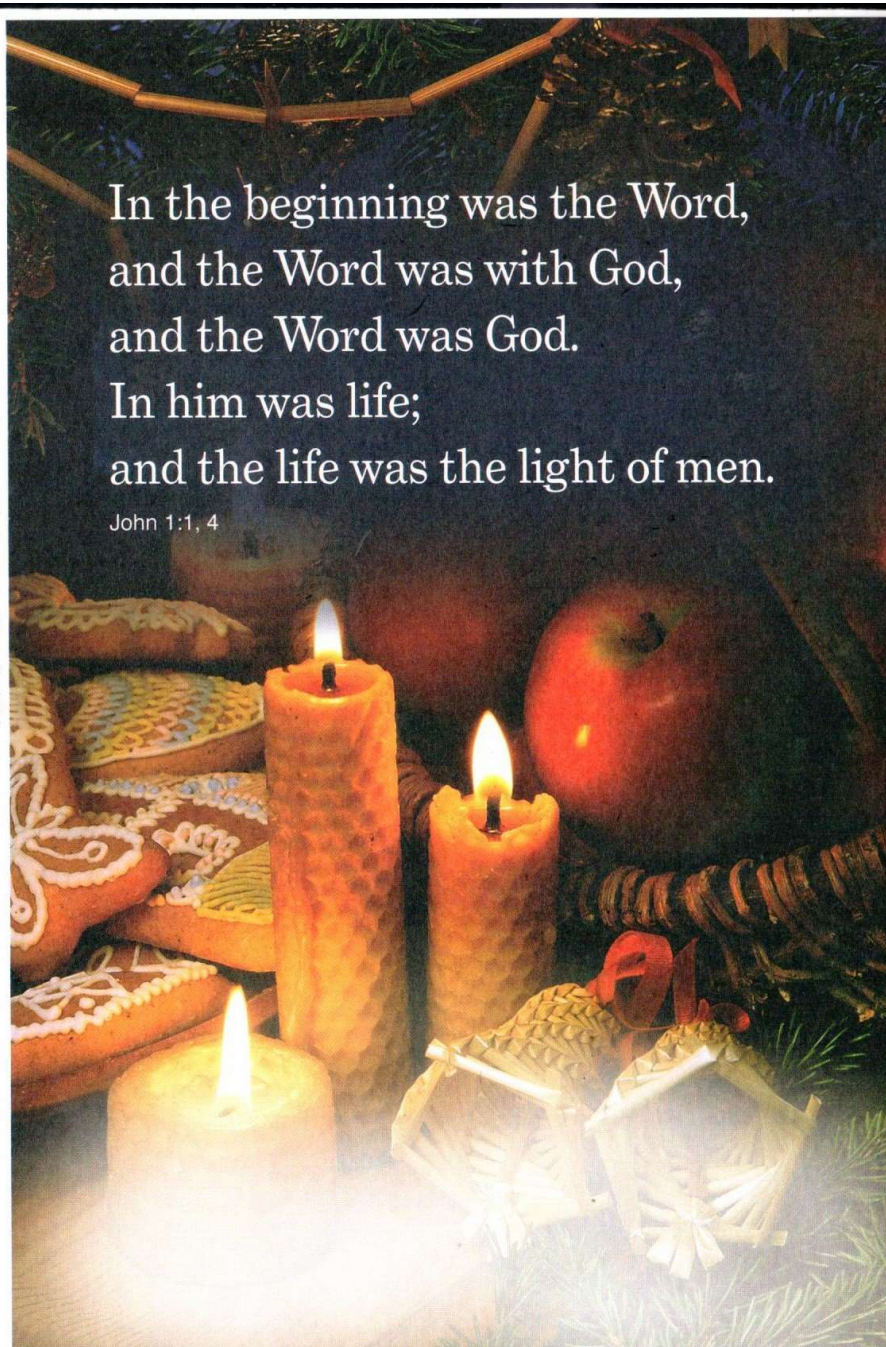
